## Members Story:

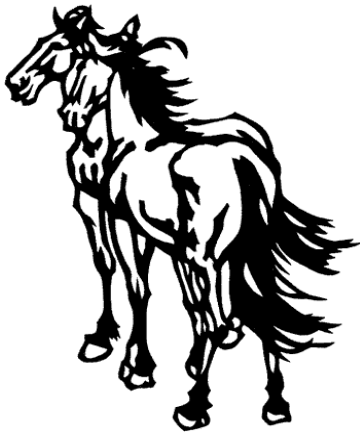
One of our members, Rhiannon Jaeger-Michael and her horse Reve Dore (Billie) was selected in the Pony Club Zone 25 Team to compete at the State Dressage Championships. She travelled to Goulburn the week-end of 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> August where she participated in the Under 15 age group. In this age group they rode novice, but still the old tests 2.1 & 2.3.

There were over 300 riders from all over NSW attending the State Championships, so the competition was strong. Rhiannon did well finishing in the top half of her age group of 75 competitors. Rhiannon and her Mum Donna, found it all a bit overwhelming, being their first state event. The horrific weather didn't help either, as Rhiannon rode in rain, sleet and strong winds. Still it was all experience.



Rhiannon also then for the EFA State Pony Dressage Championships which was held at the Sydney Equestrian Centre at Horsely Park, on 11<sup>th</sup> October. As Rhiannon only started riding official in July this year she had not done enough Novice Tests for this event, so she rode in 2 preliminary tests, 1C & 1D. They came 7<sup>th</sup> in the 1D and 9<sup>th</sup> in the 1C out of 29 competitors in these tests. The S.I.E.C. is a fantastic facility and the event was run very efficiently and everyone had a brilliant day.

Rhiannon now hopes to do a 3 day camp at S.I.E.C. in January, with the hope of qualifying for the Young Riders squad in the next year or two.

Thanks Donna and Rhiannon for letting us know how Rhiannon went. What a great effort! We look forward to hearing more of how she goes in the future.

*1. When did you start riding?*

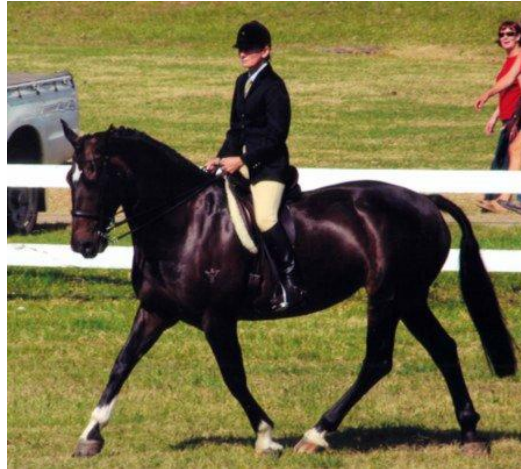
I first sat on my grandmother's horse as soon as I could sit up unassisted. However, I didn't commit to riding until I was around the age of 30.

*2. Your first/favourite horse?*

My first horse was a 3 year old thoroughbred (go figure!). My favourite horses at the moment (although unconventional for dressage) are my Clydesdale and Friesian crosses.

*3. What was your first competition?*

My first competition was at Tall Timbers Riding School at Castle Hill in Sydney in the 1960s. I rode a grey pony called "Cobweb" and I still have the ribbons we won there.

*4. Your most memorable experience?*

I don't tend to view life as containing memorable experiences which compete to be the 'most' memorable. Instead I have had lots of horse experiences (most good, some painful).

*5. The best advice anyone has ever given you?*

The advice I have taken most to heart is to always consider how any situation could be viewed from the horse's perspective. I have used this to always try and be clear and consistent in my training and appreciate my horses for what they give.

*6. Did you come from a family with a horsey background?*

My paternal grandmother in New Zealand was a very keen horsewoman and rode to hounds into her seventies. However my parents had zero interest in horses, so it must have skipped a generation.

7. *Your best buy ever?*

As far as horses are concerned, I would have to say the horse that got me serious about riding. A plain chestnut gelding with unremarkable movement, Bennelong allowed me to really enjoy riding competitively because of his super trainability and temperament. He went on to be the kids' favourite horse at Hawkesbury Vaulting Club.
